- 1. There are incidents that occur for which the medical component of the Incident Command System should be established or when a high potential for prehospital medical services may be required for:
 - 1.1 The protection of Public Safety Personnel in the performance of their duty
 - 1.2 The protection of the public at large
- 2. Applicable Incidents
 - 2.1 Hazardous materials incidents
 - 2.2 Search and rescue operations
 - 2.3 Fire operations
 - 2.4 Bomb threats, hostage and other law enforcement tactical operations
 - 2.5 Special operations by law enforcement
 - 2.6 Other situations as requested by the EMS Agency, Fire Service, or AMR field management
- 3. Dispatch and Notifications
 - 3.1 Patients are reported: a normal dispatch assignment and the AMR Field Supervisor will be notified
 - 3.2 HazMat incidents:
 - 3.2.1 San Mateo County General Hospital is also notified regardless of its proximity to the incident.
 - 3.2.2 The ambulance Contractor's (AMR) Field Supervisor will be dispatched and will request appropriate resources.
