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PUBLIC HEALTH ADVISORY- June 13, 2016 BENZATHINE PENICILLIN G SHORTAGE

Situational update

Pfizer, the sole manufacturer of Bicillin[®] L-A, has announced a temporary shortage of Bicillin[®] L-A (penicillin G benzathine suspension.) The shortage is expected to resolve by July 2016.

Penicillin G benzathine is the recommended treatment for syphilis and the only recommended treatment for pregnant women infected or exposed to syphilis.

Actions requested of clinicians:

- 1. Prioritize benzathine penicillin G (Bicillin L-A) for pregnant women with syphilis infection or exposure, as well as non-pregnant early syphilis patients with primary, secondary or early latent syphilis.
- 2. Conserve Bicillin L-A by using alternative drugs to treat group A strep pharyngitis and for primary rheumatic fever prophylaxis.
- 3. Alternatives to Bicillin L-A for non-pregnant adults with syphilis are available in the 2015 CDC treatment guidelines: <u>cdc.gov/std/tg2015/default.htm</u>.
