



Hazardous Waste Management Training for Small Quantity Generators

San Mateo County is providing **free** hazardous waste management training for businesses within the County that generate hazardous waste as part of their operations and are classified as Small Quantity Generators (SQGs). These training programs will cover the basics of hazardous waste identification, proper labeling and accumulation regulations for self-generated hazardous waste, and record keeping requirements. The training will focus on typically generated waste streams including used oil, oily debris, antifreeze, paints, batteries, and light bulbs. Participants will receive a comprehensive course manual and a certificate of completion. 2018 training dates are listed below:
