Diagnostic Information: Anticoagulants such as EDTA in venous blood specimens can	
interfere with parasite morphology and staining characteristics. This effect can be further	
compounded by excessive delay prior to making smears. If venous blood is used, at least	
2 thick and thin blood smears should be made within 1 hour of collection.
