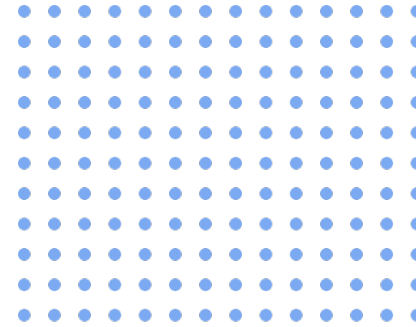




Introducing The SPOT Intake Form for Schools

Why SPOT?

The **School Portal for Outbreak Tracking (SPOT)** supports efforts to facilitate collaboration and sharing of information between schools/child care settings and their LHDs through CalCONNECT, California's public health contact tracing, outbreak reporting, and data management system. SPOT is one of several tools that can assist schools/child care settings in complying with state and local reporting requirements.



What is the SPOT Intake Form?



The SPOT Intake Form is a place for schools/child care settings to **report basic information about an exposure** at their location. The information is sent to CalCONNECT, allowing the LHD's Outbreak Team to review the information and use it to initiate important outbreak control efforts.

How do I access the SPOT Intake Form?

Navigate to the following site and select your Local Health Department:

You will be asked to enter information about the exposure at your school/child care setting. Once the information you enter is reviewed by the health department, you may be provided additional login credentials to enter specific data about persons involved in the exposure.
