**Deferred Entry of Judgment (DEJ)**  
**July 2014**

The Deferred Entry of Judgment/PC 1000 Program is designed for a population of non-sophisticated drug offenders, who enter a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to legally-specified drug related charges. The offenders are court ordered to participate in a 20-hour program that provides drug and alcohol education and counseling services. It consists of a minimum of 16 hours of group counseling, 4 hours of individual counseling, and random observed urine analysis. They are also placed on DEJ probation, usually for 12-18 months, where their performance is monitored by a special DEJ Deputy Probation Officer. Offenders satisfactorily completing DEJ probation additionally benefit by having their guilty or nolo pleas dismissed at the end of their probation term, relieving them of the legal obligation to report said conviction.

**PC 1000 DEJ Program Fee Determination/Agreement**

All fees for the DEJ Program are based on your net monthly income. Your fee will be set at the highest level unless you bring proof of your income to qualify for a lower fee.

If you fail to comply with the rules of Level One you will be required to re-contract, participate in a required alcohol/ drug assessment and enroll into Level Two. In the event you fail to comply with the rules in Level Two you will be referred back to your Probation Officer. Your Probation Officer will determine the next appropriate action.

Level One lasts 12 weeks and includes 1 group per week, 4 individual sessions (intake is the 1<sup>st</sup> session) and 3 drug tests.

Level Two requires attendance in 4 additional groups and 1 additional individual. The fee noted for Level Two is in addition to any unpaid balance in Level One. Additional drug tests, if required, are \$30.00 per test.
