San Mateo County Safe Medicine Disposal Ordinance

PLAN NAME:

San Mateo County MED-Project, A Product Stewardship Plan for

Unwanted Medicine from Households, revised August 26, 2016

PLAN OPERATOR: San Mateo County MED-Project LLC

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The San Mateo County MED-Project Stewardship Plan dated August 26, 2016 is APPROVED subject to the following conditions:

- 1. By October 14, 2016, the producers represented by San Mateo County MED-Project (MED-Project) shall propose a Supplemental Stewardship Plan including all the components of the San Mateo County Safe Medicine Disposal Ordinance (Chapter 4.116 to Title 4) for collection and disposal of the items below. The Supplemental Stewardship Plan shall be subject to review and approval.
 - a. Preloaded self-injection devices which contain a Covered Drug
 - b. Inhaler devices which contain a Covered Drug
 - c. Non-empty aerosol containers which contain a Covered Drug
 - d. Iodine containing medications
- 2. Within 60 days of approval of the Supplemental Stewardship Plan, the MED-Project shall operate the approved plan in accordance with the Ordinance.
- 3. Outreach materials shall emphasize "collection options for Covered Drugs" such as convenient kiosks, take back events and mail back options.
- 4. The MED-Project shall install collection kiosks within 60 days following an agreement signed by the collection host. Quarterly kiosk goals shall be evenly distributed between Supervisorial Districts.
- 5. Mail-back services shall be made available to all residents in conjunction with quarterly take back events to meet minimum convenience goals until minimum number of collection kiosks are installed in each Supervisorial District.



6. Call center operators shall respond to messages in a caller's preferred primary language within one business day.

7. The MED-Project will provide weekly updates on implementation progress of the

Ordinance.
