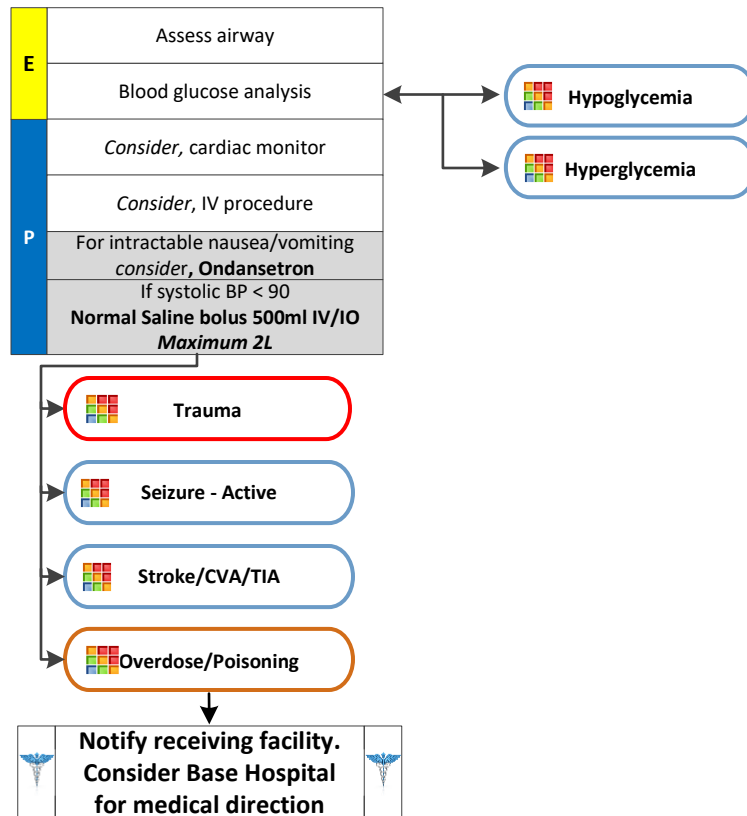


Alcohol Intoxication

For alcohol intoxication if it is the primary problem. Use of secondary primary Impression if the patient has another acute emergency

<p>History</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Known or suspected alcohol use 	<p>Signs and Symptoms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Restlessness or confusion Weakness or dizziness Flushed skin Odor of alcohol on breath 	<p>Differential</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shock (hypovolemic, cardiogenic, septic, neurogenic or anaphylaxis) Cardiac dysrhythmias Medication effect or overdose Head trauma Hypoglycemia Stroke Seizure/post-ictal

- Use caution when considering administration of opioids for pain control.
