Ligia reported on advocacy efforts by CICA, which successfully prevented cuts to Medi-Cal asset limits. Concerns were raised by the public regarding equity in Medi-Cal access. 4. 		Tsai 408 759-3756. - No updates were reported from the Supervisor Speier's Office. - Helen sent out the COD report via email. Helen shared that the San Mateo County 7th Annual Inclusion Festival will be held on 07/16/2026.
New business	- Member Orientation - Brief introduction into the Brown Act - Officer roles - SB 707- rules for teleconferencing- action item - Items for next meeting	- General overview of the Brown Act was reviewed: meetings must be public, agendas posted 72 hours in advance, items not on the agenda cannot be discussed, no private decision-making, and public comment being limited by time limits as well as restriction of back-and-forth discussions with the public. - Current chair Ligia encouraged new leadership. Officer roles (Chair, Vice Chair, and Secretary) need to be filled. A nomination committee, led by Helen along with 2 more members, will be formed. Procedural roles were also deemed outdated need to be reviewed. - SB 707 allows committees to have the option to decide, by vote, whether to hold meetings fully remote, in person, or hybrid – with voting rights preserved. A physical public access point will still be required for those without online access. Ligia motioned for a hybrid setup for a year, allowing flexibility for members with mobility, weather, or travel challenges. A public commenter emphasized the importance of in-person meetings for seniors with limited digital access. A role-call vote was made and the motion passed with all in favor. - Items for next meeting (hybrid): - Brown Act training preferably with a county attorney - Review and update of procedural rules - Election of new officer roles (action item)
