

OTHER SOURCES OF FLEXIBLE FUNDS

Whenever possible, other available and appropriate sources of special purpose funds should be utilized for before seeking mental health funds. Among such funds are:

- CORE Service Centers – These agencies (listed on next page) provide general information and referral to resources in the community; emergency assistance in the form of food, clothing, and shelter; employment information; and short-term case management.
- FSST Extraordinary Circumstances Fund – This fund is administered through the Family Self Sufficiency Teams in order to provide assistance to families who need special financial help to overcome a temporary barrier to self-sufficiency.
- Children’s Fund – Intended to provide payment for goods and services that enhance the lives of the children in the System of Care, but not to help the family achieve self-sufficiency. This fund will consider items such as prom dresses, class rings, and team uniforms to help children/youth live as normally as other children their age.
- Human Services Special Needs Account – Intended to cover the basic living needs of clients whose needs are otherwise not met through AFDC AFDC-Foster Care of other available resources. This fund most appropriately meets the needs of children and their families for basic living items.
- Family Service Agency – Family Loan Program – Provides small loans to help low-income parents without access to conventional loans cope with unexpected expenses that interfere with their ability to maintain self-sufficiency
