When the words "drug" is used, it refers to the use of prescribed or over-the-counter drugs that are used in excess of the directions and any non-medical use of drugs. The various classes of drugs may include but are not limited to: cannabis (e.g., marijuana, hash), solvents (e.g., gas, paints etc...), tranquilizers (e.g., Valium), barbiturates, cocaine, and stimulants (e.g., speed), hallucinogens (e.g., LSD) or narcotics (e.g., Heroin). Remember that the questions do not include alcohol or tobacco.

CRAFFT Alcohol & Other Drug Screening Administration & Interpretation Instructions

The CRAFFT is a 6-item, screening instrument that is used to screen for alcohol and other drug use in the adolescent population ages 14 to 18 years old. The CRAFFT takes approximately 5 minutes to administer and score.

Administration: The CRAFFT is a self-administered screening but it can be read to the adolescent if necessary.

Scoring and Interpretation: Score (1) point for each "YES" answer. A score of (2) or more indicates the need for further assessment.

CRAFFT Score	Degree of Problem Related to Alcohol/Other Drug Abuse	Suggested Action
0 - 1	No problems reported	None at this time.
2 or More	Potential of a significant problem.	Assessment required.

If a provider agency elects to use the following screening tools, the SMAST and DAST, in order to do a comprehensive screen for substance abuse, they must be used together as one screens only for alcohol and the other only for drug abuse.
