WHO:

Volunteers are needed to help pick up litter in neighborhoods in San Mateo County. Cleanups will be self-guided and start at your front door.

WHEN:

Coastal Cleanup 2022 is all September long!





WHERE:

Individuals and households are encouraged to clean up litter in their local neighborhoods.



HOW TO PARTICIPATE:

- 1. **Pick a day** or multiple days in September to pick up litter in your neighborhood solo or with family, friends, or a neighbor.
- 2. RSVP here!
- 3. **Download the <u>Clean Swell app</u>** in the <u>Apple Store</u> or <u>Google</u> <u>Play</u> before the event so you are ready to record the litter you collect.



- 4. **Read the latest <u>San Mateo County safety protocols</u>** to protect yourself from COVID-19 exposure during the cleanup.
- 5. **BYO** (bring your own) buckets, bags, gloves or litter grabbers, reusable water bottle, sunscreen, and a hat to pick up litter.
- 6. **Record litter** you pick up using the <u>Clean Swell app</u>. Don't pick up anything hazardous, sharp, heavy, or not man-made!
- 7. **Dispose of trash and recycle the litter** you removed in your home garbage waste bins.
