Section 17341. Equipment Construction  All equipment used for the collection and/or transportation of solid waste shall be durable, easily cleanable and designed for safe handling, and constructed to prevent loss of wastes from the equipment during collection or transportation. If such equipment is used to collect or transport garbage, other wet or liquid producing wastes, or wastes composed of fine particles, such equipment shall in all cases be non-absorbent and leak resistant. All equipment shall be maintained in good condition and cleaned in a frequency and in a manner so as to prevent the propagation or attraction of flies, rodents, or other vectors and the creation of nuisances.  Section 17344. Identification of Operator  Each vehicle or container box used for the collection and transport of refuse shall be clearly marked with the name of the agency or firm operating the vehicle and a specific identification number for each box container or truck.
Section 17343. Equipment Parking Location A refuse collection service operator must designate an off-street location where all refuse collection vehicles will be parked when not in service, except in an emergency.
