Update re: Emotional Support Animals

Effective as of: 01/01/2023

What: An update to regulations around Emotional Support Animal letters. **Who:** All licensed/registered staff.

Details: The BBS has notified licensees/registrants that the law regarding emotional support animal letters (SB 774) has been updated to exempt verified homeless/unhoused individuals from the 30-day client-provider established relationship requirement.
