If emailed comments are received after 5:00p.m. on the day before the meeting, the CoD will make every effort to either (i) provide such emailed comments to the CoD and make such emails publicly available on the agenda website prior to the meeting, or (ii) read such emails during the meeting. Whether such emailed comments are forwarded and posted, or are read during the meeting, they will still be included in the administrative record.
