## What to Bring to Your Health Coverage Screening Appointment

In order to determine your eligibility for any of the public health insurance/coverage programs or coverage through the State Health Insurance Exchange (Covered CA), you may be required to submit information verifying your identity, income, residency/immigration status and/or property. To speed up the application process, it would be helpful if you bring the documents below to your initial meeting. Please note that all documents must be current, fully legible and, if available, originals. Not all verifications are mandatory for all programs. Please confirm when scheduling your appointment which of these verifications might apply to you.

Verification Requested A		Acceptable Documents
1.	Identification	State I.D. card, Driver's license, school or college I.D. card or passport.
2.	Residency	Uitility Bill, or other official document indicating your correct residential address
3.	Immigration Status	Certificate of Naturalization, Alien Registration card (Green Card), other USCIS immigration documents (Amnesty card, U Visa, DACA visa, HB1 or HB2 work visa or other), official Immigration Judge Order, U.S. Passport or birth certificate.
4.	Social Security Card	Actual card or receipt that you applied for a card.
5.	Earned Income	<ul><li>a) Most recent income tax return for 2012 or 2013 (all pages), or</li><li>b) pay stubs or letter from employer or</li><li>c) If self employed, profit/loss statement for past quarter.</li></ul>
6.	Unearned income	Social Security Award letter (or bank statement showing monthly benefits deposit), VA benefits, Worker's Compensation statement, Unemployment or State Disability letter or account printout (if EDD debit cardholder), Letter of Support, Child Support statement, Loan Agreement (all that apply).
7.	Bank Accounts	Bank statements for month of application, Closing statement for all accounts closed within past 24 months regardless of closing amount.
8.	Life Insurance	Complete copy of policy showing face value and cash surrender value.
9.	Vehicles	Vehicle registration and car payment information for all vehicles you own.
10.	Other Assets	Copy of mortgage statement/property tax/HOA fee/title insurance, stocks/bonds balance sheet, mutual funds account statement, retirement or trust account statement (all that apply).
