Written Comment:

Written comment may be emailed in advance of the meeting. Please read the following instructions carefully:

- 1. Your written comment should be emailed to <u>crochester@smcgov.org</u>
- 2. Your email should include the specific agenda item on which you are commenting or note that your comment concerns an item that is not on the agenda.
- 3. Members of the public are limited to one comment per agenda item
- 4. The length of the emailed comment should be commensurate with the two minutes customarily allowed for verbal comments, which is approximately 250-300 words
- 5. If your emailed comment is received by 5:00 p.m. on the day before the meeting, it will be provided to the Members of the BHC. If emailed comments are received after 5:00 p.m. on the day before the meeting, the Executive Secretary will make every effort to either (i) provide such emailed comments to the BHC, or (ii) reach such emails during the meeting. Whether such emailed comments are forwarded or are read during the meeting, they will still be included in the meeting minutes.
