CLINICAL PEARL

According to the American Academy of Pediatrics and the Children's Hospital Association's most recent report dated September 9, 2021, nearly 5.3 million children have tested positive for COVID-19 since the onset of the pandemic. Over 243,000 cases were added the past week, the second highest number of child cases in a week since the pandemic began. After declining in early summer, child cases have increased exponentially, with nearly 500,000 cases in the past 2 weeks. Since the pandemic began, children represented 15.5% of total cumulated cases. For the week ending September 9, children made up 28.9% of reported weekly COVID-19 cases (children under the age of 18 constitute 22.2% of the US population). At this time, the available data indicate that severe illness due to COVID-19, COVID-19 associated hospitalization and death are uncommon among children. However, there is an urgent need to collect more data on longerterm impacts of the pandemic on children, including ways the virus may harm the long-term physical health of infected children, as well as its emotional and mental health effects.
