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CLINICAL PEARL

• Researchers have shown that it is theoretically possible to create a vaccine that protects not just against COVID-19 and its variants, but also related distinct viruses in the same family that are also responsible for disease. According to a Nature article, a protein-based nanoparticle vaccine together with a common adjuvant (alum) generated cross-neutralizing antibodies in a macaque model. The vaccine's elicited antibodies neutralizing batCoVs, SARS-CoV-1, SARS-CoV-2, and SARS-CoV-2 variants B.1.1.7 (UK), P.1 (Brazil), and B.1.351 (South Africa). This receptor-binding domain (RBD)-based vaccine provided protective immunity against SARS-CoV-2 in the immunized macaques. Interestingly, an mRNA version of this vaccine also elicited antibodies against SARS-CoV-1 and batCoVs, albeit at lower titers than the protein nanoparticle version. These data demonstrate the possibility of not only highly efficacious specific vaccines for emergent zoonotic viruses, but general vaccines against entire families of viruses as well.


