VISITING RULES SNF 1A



Monday–Friday, 10am to 8pm Saturday–Sunday, 10am to 4pm

Visiting rules and hours are subject to change.

<u>Appointments are recommended</u> to help prepare for your arrival. To schedule a visit, call (650) 573-3678.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT THE HOSPITAL

- Visitors must be <u>fully vaccinated</u> against COVID-19. Proof of COVID-19 vaccination must be provided at the hospital entrances. Please show your ID.
 - » "Fully vaccinated" means: two weeks or more after receiving the second dose of the vaccine.
- If a visitor is <u>not fully vaccinated</u> for COVID-19, proof of a negative PCR COVID-19 test taken within 48 hours must be provided before each visit.
- If patient is in critical condition: visitors will be allowed without the vaccination and testing requirements, but must follow the unit's infection control protocols.
- All visitors will be screened for COVID-19 symptoms and close contact with COVID-19 in the last 10 days.
- Masks are required.
- Visitors must clean their hands with alcohol-based hand rub before entering the hospital <u>AND</u> before entering the visitation area.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT SNF 1A

- Show proof of vaccination again AND proof of a negative PCR test done within the last 48 hours.
 - » If you do not have a PCR test result, bring an antigen (at home) test with you and take it in front of one of our nurses. If you don't have an antigen test, we may be able to provide one.
 - Negative test: you will be allowed to visit.
 - + **Positive test:** you will <u>not</u> be allowed to visit.
- You must sign in AND out of our visitation log.

WHILE YOU'RE VISITING

- Two (2) visitors per resident at a time is recommended.
- Staff will regularly check to ensure that infection control and safety protocols are followed during the visit.
- Children are allowed if able to follow all infection control protocols.

PATIENTS UNDER QUARANTINE OR IN ISOLATION

- Visitors must use personal protective equipment (PPE), as provided and instructed by staff.
- Visitors will be informed of their risks of exposure.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Cleaning AND disinfecting of the visitation area will be done by staff after each visit.
- Visitors who do not follow the Visitation Rules will be asked to leave and/or may not be allowed to visit.
