Dear In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) Provider:

The California Department of Social Services (CDSS) is sending information to IHSS providers and recipients to explain recent changes in State law affecting payment in the IHSS program. **Effective February 1, 2016**, this new law allows for IHSS providers to be paid for overtime and/or travel time when certain requirements are met.

ACTIONS YOU MUST TAKE:

- Read the notices sent from the State
- Complete and sign the form(s) sent from the State:
 - All providers must sign and return the IHSS Program Provider Enrollment Agreement (SOC 846) no later than April 15, 2016.
- Providers who work for more than one recipient will receive additional information from the State in February about how to claim travel time.
