



## The Challenge

We face a cascading mental health emergency driven by systemic upstream conditions —loneliness, rising costs, climate instability, technology-mediated harms, employment uncertainty, and declining public trust.



## Why It Matters

With County mental health services transforming in response to Prop 1, come July 2026, an estimated 75%+ of prevention funding in Behavioral Health & Recovery Services will sunset – at a time when upstream stressors are intensifying.



## UN's Declaration on Future Generations









## Our Goals by 2027

- 2. Empower: Gather 10,000 ideas from young people and deliver a "Reimagining Mental Health" agenda to shape the county's next vision; and make sure young people have real seats at the table on every county board and commission
- 3. Design: Launch a county-wide "Well-being Holiday of the Future" challenge where the best ideas get built.
- 4. **Inspire:** Share our story, host events, activate other localities, and connect with our global movement during the *2026 FIFA World Cup*.
- **5. Deliver:** An *implementable commitment* from the County to embed foresight and intergenerational well-being into its ongoing strategy, planning, and action be it through a formalized Futures Commission, Commissioner or legislation.



**Founded** – 2021

Mission – Youth Action Board (YAB) embeds youth voice, youth lived experience and youth leadership in county mental and behavioral health decision making

**Results** – 4 cohorts later, the YAB has matured into a youth-led, adult scaffolded structure with a track record of impact and improving lives at scale


