BLACK BOX

Highlights important information



**G01 General –
Routine Medical Care Protocol**

Will be used on all patients and will not appear on individual protocols

RED BOX

Highlights critical information

May direct to another protocol



Signals protocol within a protocol

Information box

Decision Point
Darker outline to highlight

System of Care notification

Teal Shading
Specialty hospital information and alerting when criteria are met

Indicates entry/exit from/to another protocol(s) – color coordinated with category



Red Shading of Information Box Medication (Bolded) Contraindicated
Base contact advised if you want to administer

Gray Shading of Information Box Medication (Bolded) Administration
Dosages found on SMC Drug Card
Normal face provides guidance if present

Orange Shading of Information Box
Indicates transport decision based boxes that may not be to the closest hospital

R	Emergency Medical Responder
L	Law Enforcement Officer
E	Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)
O	EMT Optional Scope
P	Paramedic

Notification and Medical Direction Legend		
	Notify receiving facility. Consider Base Hospital for medical direction
