

Hazardous Waste Management Training for Small Quantity Generators

San Mateo County Environmental Health Department is providing **free** hazardous waste management training for businesses within San Mateo County that generate hazardous waste as part of their operations and are classified as small quantity generators (SQGs). This training program covers the basics of hazardous waste identification, proper labeling, and accumulation, transportation, and disposal regulations for self-generated hazardous waste and universal waste as well as applicable recordkeeping requirements.
