

Regular Agenda: Consent Agenda	All items on Consent Agenda (meeting minutes from September 13, 2018) were approved.	Consent Agenda was <u>MOVED</u> by Robert <u>SECONDED</u> by Christian, and APPROVED by all Board members present.
Reporting Agenda: Review of Budget & Finance Report through September	Jim Beaumont reported on status of the budget, expenditures, and unexpended funds, providing a brief background on program expenditures and how previous grants and funding efforts to specific clinics helped lend to the increases in unexpended funds. Currently projected to have ~ \$267,000 in unexpended funds, a decrease from last month and significantly better than the \$600,000 we ended up with last year.	
Reporting Agenda: Contract Spend Down 2018 January to August	Jim Beaumont reported that contractors were doing better this year, expending at an aggregate low 90% rate, but that since we pay invoices a month behind, December 2017, which was a very low month for contact expenditure, was weighing down the expenditure weight for contracts overall. Note that LifeMoves expenditure rate was up substantially the past 3 months.	
Reporting Agenda: Small Funding Request update	Reported that we had received a new template to use for approving/agreeing to small funding proposals and that the process would now be able to go forward this year. Committee decided no meeting for November.






