How Much Does ACE Cost?

Health coverage keeps you health and covered when you need it most.

San Mateo County Access and Care for Everyone (ACE) is a low cost health coverage option for San Mateo County residents.



ACE services are only covered by certain providers:

- San Mateo Medical Center's main campus and clinics
- · Ravenswood Family Health Center
- North East Medical Services

Once enrolled, you will select a primary care provider clinic where you will receive primary care, any referrals to specialized medical services, and prescriptions at certain pharmacies.

Sign up for free health coverage with ACE Fee Waiver if you:

- 1. Are a San Mateo County resident, between the of ages 19 to 64.
- 2. Have an income between 138% and 200% Federal Poverty Level (FPL). FPL levels differ depending on the size of your family.

FPL Annual Income Levels

The above income guidelines are effective April 1, 2016 through March 31, 2017.

 Are not eligible for Medicare, Full Scope No Cost or Share-of Cost Medi-Cal, Covered California, private insurance, or other third party payers.

If your income is below 138% FPL, you may be eligible for the Ace Fee Waiver program.

The annual enrollment fee is \$360 per person. This can be paid in monthly installments or waived based on your ability to pay.

With ACE, the most you would pay out of pocket is \$1,000 (\$360 enrollment and \$640 in co-payments). Co-payments range from:

- \$7 prescriptions
- \$15 diabetes, asthma, hypertension visit
- \$75 emergency room visit
- \$300 same day surgery

How Can I Sign Up?

Enrollment counselors are available to help you!

When you sign up, bring proof of your residence in San Mateo County, household income, and identity.

Drop in at HCU enrollment sites Monday-Friday, 8:30am-5pm, and every 3rd Saturday of the month, 8am-4:30pm (at SMMC only).

HCU offices and the hotline are closed each month on the 2nd Thursday, 2:30-5pm, and the last Thursday, 8:30-10:30am.
