Who are we?

The San Mateo County HIV Program Community Board is a community planning group that provides input into the prioritization and allocation of resources for HIV/AIDS programs and services in the County. We also provide input to the San Francisco HIV Health Services Planning Council for their prioritization and allocation process.



When do we meet?

We support the mission of the San Mateo County HIV Program. The Program provides comprehensive, community-based prevention and testing services, HIV/AIDS related health care, medical case management, harm reduction

therapy, and referrals to community agencies providing housing assistance, food assistance, dental care and emergency financial assistance.

Members of the community board provide input to the HIV Program around services needed by the community. We participate in the annual HIV Program service prioritization process.

Who do we serve?

We serve people at risk for and living with HIV/AIDS in San Mateo County and their families. We focus on underserved populations and communities who are at risk for HIV.
