Who is Eligible

- ✓ Persons who meet the federal criteria of Chronic Homelessness or Homeless
- ✓ Medi-Cal Health Plan member
- ✓ Frequent Hospitalization
- ✓ Income at 15% - 20% AMI
- ✓ Enrolled or eligible for field-based case management
- ✓ San Mateo County resident

About the Program

"The San Mateo County Housing for a Healthy California Program (HHC) will provide approximately 80 supportive housing units staggered over two years across four new projects, two in the Redwood City area and two in the Daly City area. Most, but not all, of these units will come with a project-based housing voucher. Middlefield Junction is the first project to come on line."

Referral Process

- Submit the Pre-Screening & Attestation Form with the Authorization to Release Information
- If the applicant is eligible, you will be sent an e-mail link to complete the application form
- If eligible, you will be notified to complete the Developer application and Housing Authority application form.
- If eligible, the project Property Management Agent (PM) and the County of San Mateo Housing Authority will conduct screening and interviews.



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
