Re-opening Episodes

Effective: Now

It has come to the attention of QM that staff may benefit from additional guidance to determine when it is clinically appropriate to request a closed episode be re-opened for a returning client.

All requests to reopen closed episodes of clients who were discharged more than 45 days after the last discharge must be sent to [HS BHRS ASK QM@smcgov.org](mailto:HS_BHRS_ASK_QM@smcgov.org) for approval before going to MIS so that QM can support you in applying the criteria outlined in BHRS Policy [16-01](#) when making this determination.

New 5150 Training Requirements

Effective: Now

Reminder: Effective January 1, 2026, all BHRS staff and contractors certified to initiate a 72-hour hold must complete two new SB43 training courses in addition to the existing CalMHSA 5150 training before a new or renewal certification card will be issued. Required training list:

- CalMHSA 5150 training
- SB43 Introduction & Orientation for 5150 Certified Card Holders
- SB43 Application of Expanded Criteria in the Field for 5150 Card Holders
