		They are now delivering 150 meals/day.
		SMC Aging & Adult Services have been educating the Great Plates
		Delivered recipients and 20% of them require meal assistance and
		have self attestated that they are eligible for home delivered meals.
		SMC has not received official notice about extra funding from the
		State of CA for OAA Congregate and Home Delivered meals.
		Second Course Program delivers meals to individuals who are eligible
		for it. Most recipients of the GPD do not know about the Second
		Course Program and need to be educated about it.
		Second Harvest is providing grocery deliveries to the individuals who
		were receiving meals from GPD and do not need help with meal

At this time, we do not know how many people are receiving the grocery deliveries.</li> <li>Some of the GPD recipients are unsatisfied with the meals offered through Second Course Program and Home Delivered Meals and are canceling the services. We are educating them on the difference between food need and food preference. This is a program for those who have no other options/assistance with meals.</li> </ul>
