4. Revise/Approve	Commissioner Porter moved to accept; Commissioner Lee
September, 2023	seconded. Commissioners Barsi, Giannini and Arnos abstained.
Minutes	The Minutes were approved.
5. Committee Work Plan Implementation	 a. Help at Home: Subcommittee Report: Commissioner Barsi reported that the only sections remaining to be finished are Transportation and the contribution by Aging and Adult Services. Anna Sawamura said her department's section would be available before the end of the month. Commissioners Lee and Barsi will meet to work on finalizing the revisions. A version showing all updates is expected to be available for circulation to all Commissioners for input in November. Completion of updates is expected by the end of November. An updated version of the guide should be available in early 2024. Discussion of using the updated version to publicize the guide with a "blast." Announcements on Facebook page, possible article in Daily Journal, etc. Committee members to think about feasible methods, venues for publicity. Discussion of making Help at Home guide available to discharge planners at hospitals, through Meals on Wheels, MELP, etc. Tabling: Subcommittee Report: Commissioner Porter provided updates on tabling statistics. A total of 1162 Help at Home guides have been distributed through tabling events since we started keeping track. 18 events have been staffed in 2023, with 3 more scheduled before the end of the year. Building Relationships Commissioner Lee noted that in 2022 and early 2023 there often were 40 or more members of the public on Zoom during the General Meeting. On October 16 there were only 14. Commissioner Lee will have the Buddy list (updated version is attached) circulated to all Commissioners for updates and suggest that Commissioners make contact with their city

	buddies before the holidays. Also discussed was reaching out to faith-based communities. Commissioner Arnos stated that most SMC Commissions have representatives at the San Mateo County Spirituality Initiative for Mental Health. www.smchealth.org/spirituality-initiative . CoA does not, but should investigate the possibility. Also discussed as worthy of further investigation were the Redwood City Spotlight and the Pacifica Age Friendly Community Coalition. It was noted that the MISO Committee also was discussing faith based communities and that coordination should be explored.
6. Review of Work Plan	 a. Goals: Discussion that Goals I and II have been largely achieved except the "intergenerational event" portion. Goal III, relating to age friendly efforts, will need further work. b. Timelines and goals to be reviewed as part of upcoming Strategy session.

8. Publicity, Facebook, Website Issues	 a. Composition: Commissioner Lee followed up with Anna Sawamura regarding the review by County Counsel of the CoA composition issue. Commissioners noted that representation by the Board of Supervisors at CoA meetings has apparently ended but should be resumed. b. Visibility: See Help at Home discussion
