Path to tabling: Mr. Eng reported that the Commission on Disability is holding its 3rd Annual Inclusion Festival in Redwood City on August 11, 2022. Commissioner Taylor volunteered to table; Commissioner Lee signed up the CoA for attendance at the event. Commissioner Lee reported that she is keeping an event spreadsheet. There was a mention that National Night Out, a police department event, will take place on August 2 and might present tabling opportunities. Commissioners agreed to check with their local police departments. (San Mateo has an event at King Center, but there are no tabling opportunities for CoA) b. The Help at Home Flyer is being finalized; Commissioner Querol-Moreno volunteered to take on this task. Chinese and Spanish versions of the guide are still not completed c. Commissioners will provide updated information about city communication partners and also include information about their communities' Age Friendly Task Force member. The CoA trifold brochure has been updated and will be finalized shortly. d. There was a lengthy discussion about the structure of the January 2023 anniversary event. Commissioner Lee offered to circulate texts of the emails used in 2021 (and did after the meeting). No decisions were made yet. e. There was no discussion about intergenerational events.
