Community Health Worker/Promotores de Salud Target Population: Adult Farmworkers

Expected Services

- Contractor will develop and implement a Promotores health model on the Coastside that will serve as a liaison between farmworkers/their dependents and SMMC and SMC Health
- The Promotora(s) will provide a range of supportive services, including but not limited to:
 - health education
 - · pesticide safety
 - · health insurance assistance
 - · referrals to health resources
 - support in seeing their primary care physicians

Expected Outcomes

- Increase the overall number farmworkers and dependents that access SMMC and SMCH services, especially adult farmworkers
- Increase number of clients signed up for Medi-Cal and ACE
- Increase knowledge about women's health, pesticide exposure, and chronic disease
- Improve health outcomes in diabetes management, first trimester clinic appointments, and cancer screenings [align with a few QI/QA goals]
- Increase farmworker trust in SMMC/SMCH as an institution



Care Management linked to Street/Field/ Mobile/NPCC Target Population: Street and Shelter Homeless Individuals

Expected Services

- Provide outreach and health education
- · Conduct initial assessments
- Help clients adhere to care management plan developed in consultation with medical provider
- Ensure clients make their scheduled appointments
- Assisting clients with completion and renewal of health insurance coverage
- Provide information to clients about health and community resources

Expected outcomes

- Increase the overall number of people experiencing homelessness that access SMMC and SMCH services
- Increase number of clients signed up for Medi-Cal and ACE
- Improve health outcomes in diabetes management, cancer screenings, depression [align with a few QI/QA goals]
