

San Mateo County TB testing

Anyone can get tuberculosis (TB), but some people are more at risk than others. If you are concerned that you are at risk for TB, please speak to your doctor about getting tested. It is the only way to find out if you have the TB germs in your body.

Are you at risk for TB?

- **Were you born in or have you lived in a country (for over a month) where TB is common?**
This includes anywhere in Africa, Asia, Mexico, Central or South America, the Caribbean and Eastern Europe.
- **Have you lived with or spent time with someone who has had TB?**
- **Are you a person living with HIV/AIDS or have you received an organ transplant? Do you take medication that weakens your immune system?**

If you answered YES on any of the questions above, you may need a TB test.
