- 1. Training** - The County will train school staff on how to safely manage the school share table.
- 2. Student Education** – Fun games will be played with students during the lunch hour to show students how to use the school share table.
- 3. Starter Toolkit** - A school share table How-to Guide, a parent flyer in various languages, four food-grade bins with signage, and a school wall poster will be provided.
