



Commission on Aging – Social Isolation and Transportation Committee (SIT) Meeting Minutes

1. Call to Order

Chair Liana called the meeting to order at 3:02 p.m. Committee members, staff, and members of the public introduced themselves.

2. Note-taking Assignment

Commissioner Vico agreed to take notes.

3. Public Comment

No public comment was recorded.

4. Approve Agenda (2/12/2026)

5. Approve Prior Minutes / Review Notes

Action: Motion Vico; Second Taylor. The Committee approved the October 9, 2025 minutes.

The Committee reviewed notes from the November 13, 2025 and January 8, 2026 meetings; those meetings did not have quorum, so no actions were taken and the notes were not approved as minutes.

6. SamTrans Report

Margaret Baggerly provided an update on SamTrans mobility resources and outreach efforts, including travel training and community education. Key resources and outreach channels discussed included the mobility guide, PeninsulaRide.com, events and



presentations, tabling, and community partnerships. The Committee discussed increasing outreach and one-on-one guidance opportunities in early 2026.

7. Update on Intergenerational Connections Project / Survey

Adele Ryono shared updates on intergenerational programming, including “Once Upon a Time...An Intergenerational Storytime,” with events planned on March 14, 2026 (Half Moon Bay Library) and March 22, 2026 (North Fair Oaks Library). An update was also provided regarding the “Talk Across Time” research study, including a staffing transition due to the principal investigator’s health issues.

8. Work Plan Progress

The Committee discussed coordination and engagement opportunities related to transportation and social isolation efforts, including aligning with relevant SamTrans advisory processes and communications pathways. The SamTrans senior showcase remained on hold. The RDA consultant report was anticipated around April or May. Members discussed outreach strategies to ensure information reaches residents across the county, including coastal communities.

9. Announcements

Items shared included a potential outreach connection for intergenerational event promotion and a request to place SB 707 on a future agenda for discussion. A Brown Act-related item was noted for follow-up/updates at a future meeting as needed.
