




Total COVID-19 cases





Because of limited testing capacity, the number of cases detected through testing represents only a small portion of the total number of likely cases in the County. COVID-19 data are reported as timely, accurately, and completely as we have available. Data are updated as we receive information that is more complete and will change over time as we learn more. Cases are lab-confirmed COVID-19 cases reported to San Mateo County Public Health by providers, commercial laboratories, and academic laboratories, including reporting results through the California Reportable Disease Information Exchange.




