Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) Edison STD Clinic

A \$25 fee is expected at time of service.

Please note that there will be no doctor or nurse available on Tuesdays.

Can I get an appointment to be seen at the STD Clinic, so I don't have to wait in line?

No. The Edison STD Clinic is a first come, first serve clinic. No appointments are necessary. Please expect to wait as this is a walk-in clinic. I

f maximum capacity is reached, registration may close, and you may be referred to another clinic day.

What is a Testing Only Clinic (TUESDAYS)?

You may come in and receive standard STD/HIV testing for a \$25 fee. Standard testing includes Rapid HIV (finger-stick specimen), Chlamydia and gonorrhea (urine specimen) tests. **No doctor/nurse will be available.** Testing for syphilis, hepatitis C, and/or herpes, may require an additional fee: Syphilis - \$13 | Hepatitis C - \$19 | Herpes - \$28

Symptoms Clinic (THURSDAYS)?

This means that we will see patients with symptoms of an STD, such as pain, itching, discharge, sores or rash, need medicine or need to see a doctor, and will include testing if necessary. If you only want to be tested for STDs/HIV and do not need to see a doctor, please come on a Tuesday as it will likely have a shorter wait time for testing. However, testing is also offered on Thursdays.

I have a symptom (ex: pain, swelling, itch, sore, wart) that I want looked at. When should I come to the clinic?

Symptoms will only be looked at by a trained medical provider. These will only be available on Thursday Symptoms Clinic, from 4-7 PM.

I want to be tested for "everything". When should I come?

Standard STD/HIV testing includes a Rapid HIV (finger-stick specimen), Chlamydia and gonorrhea (urine). If you want testing for syphilis, herpes and/or hepatitis C testing, you may be required to pay an additional fee. These tests can be performed every Tuesday or Thursday from 4-7 PM.

Can I get medicine on Tuesdays?

No. You must come in on Thursdays for any treatment (medicine) for a STD. No medicine will be given out on Tuesday Testing Clinics.

I just had sex with someone, and I'm scared I got something. Everything feels fine but I want to get checked. When do I come?

If you just want to be tested for STDs and/or HIV, then come on Tuesday or Thursday. If you have symptoms and want to have a doctor look at anything or want an exam, you can only come on *Thursday Symptoms Clinic*. There will be no doctor available on Tuesday Testing Only Clinics.

What forms of payment do you accept?

Cash and checks only. Credit cards/Debit Cards are not accepted.

Can I use my private insurance?

We do not recommend using private insurance because the cost for services is greater than our standard clinic fees. As a result, you may receive a bill that is much larger than the \$25 fee.

What services do you not offer?

We do not offer birth control, pap smears, or HPV testing. We do not offer primary care or urgent care services outside of evaluation for STDs.

Are there other places to get STD/HIV testing? Yes!
