1. Chair Michael Mau called the meeting to order at 3pm.
2. Note taking: Michael.
3. Public Comment: David Scarbor, new runs started largely returning school bus routes; also a return to transit marketing campaign with MTC is underway; Cal-Trains offering half off services for the month; Cal-Trans increased ridership, but SamTrans ridership is still below normal.
4. Agenda reviewed and accepted.
5. Prior meeting notes reviewed and accepted.
6. Member Reports:  
Commissioner Leth – attended meeting on Alternative Congestion Relief group, working on definition of group, and reviewing future projects; reviewed Measure A and W funds spread out over many years; also attended new CAFE age friendly meeting for Half Moon Bay, joined by Christina Dimas Kahn.  
Commissioner Lee – new Hillsdale CalTrans station reopened and is much nicer,  
Commissioner Mau – CaR Program operating, ridership starting to rise; and Senior Center has reopened; Age Friendly Task Force still meeting by Zoom monthly.  
Commissioner McMullin - San Carlos started its Age Friendly Task Force, but did not join it as he is already on the Core team; it does have a Villages rep., and also Angela Gianni may be participating. Senior Center looking into using an accessible Van. Villages of the Coastside is starting to expand thru the North Coast.  
Commissioner Uhl - Burlingame Age Friendly application about to be submitted to AARP. One of the projects to be information to Seniors, and another reviewing transportation issues like traffic light / curb study;
7. New Business: Christina Ugaitafa reported that NBC meeting on 21st will have a transportation panel of 6 senior ridership programs; also funding for a new project thru 2022 could be transportation related. David Scarbor reported that SamTrans and RediWheels are offering free rides to booster vaccination sites.
