# **Alcohol Intoxication**

For alcohol intoxication if it is the primary problem. Use of secondary primary Impression if the patient has another acute emergency

### History


· Known or suspected alcohol use

### Signs and Symptoms

- Restlessness or confusion
- · Weakness or dizziness
- Flushed skin
- Odor of alcohol on breath

### Differential

- Shock (hypovolemic, cardiogenic, septic, neurogenic or anaphylaxis)
- Cardiac dysrhythmias
- Medication effect or overdose
- Head trauma
- Hypoglycemia
- Stroke
- Seizure/post-ictal



## **Pearls**

• Use caution when considering administration of opioids for pain control.
