

Process for enrolling undoc and mixed status families that are eligible for ACE Fee Waiver and Restricted Medi-Cal

Case 1: Undoc mom, undoc child, household income 0-138% FPL

Program eligibility :

Undoc mom is eligible for ACE FW and Restricted Medi-Cal
Undoc child is eligible for Full Scope Medi-Cal

HSA-HCU pilot staff:

Process ACE FW for mom in One-e-App (OeA),
Process Restricted Medi-Cal for mom and Full Scope Medi-Cal for child in CalWin.

Non-pilot HCU staff and CBOs:

Process ACE FW for mom in One-e-App,
Process Restricted Medi-Cal for mom and Full Scope Medi-Cal for child in OeA.

IMPORTANT Note1: Be sure to opt out of Healthy Kids for child in OeA, since OeA is still programmed to enroll undoc children with household income below 266% FPL for Healthy Kids.

IMPORTANT Note2: OeA will still determine Restricted Medi-Cal for undoc children under 266% FPL instead of Full Scope Medi-Cal. However, when the Medi-Cal case for the undoc child is referred to HSA, they will determine the child eligible for Full Scope Medi-Cal.

Case 2: Undoc mom, doc child, household income 0-138% FPL

Program eligibility:

Undoc mom is eligible for ACE FW and Restricted Medi-Cal
Doc child is eligible for Full Scope Medi-Cal

HSA-HCU pilot staff – same as Case 1:

Process ACE FW for mom in One-e-App,
Process Restricted Medi-Cal for mom and Full Scope Medi-Cal for child in CalWin

Non-pilot HCU staff and CBOs:

Process ACE FW for mom in One-e-App,
Process Restricted Medi-Cal for mom and Full Scope Medi-Cal for child in OeA.

IMPORTANT Note: Since OeA does not determine Full Scope Medi-Cal eligibility for the documented child, make sure you include a note in OeA (not the fax cover sheet) stating that the documented child on the application is applying for Full Scope Medi-Cal.
