Overview of MHSA Innovation (INN)



Mental Health Services Act - Prop 63 (2004)

1% tax on personal income above \$1 million



Community Services & Supports (CSS)

Direct treatment and recovery services for serious mental illness and serious emotional disturbance



Prevention & Early Intervention (PEI)

Interventions prior to the onset of mental health disorders and early onset of psychotic disorders



Innovation (INN)

New approaches and community-driven best practices

MHSA Innovation (INN)

- 5% of MHSA funding allocated to innovative ideas
 - For San Mateo County, this means about \$2.15M per year for new projects
- 3 to 5-year pilot projects to develop new best practices
- INN Projects must be approved by the State before implementation



INN Project Requirements

Project must meet one of the following requirements:

- 1. Introduce a <u>new</u> practice or approach
- 2. Make <u>a change</u> to an existing practice, including application to a different population
- 3. Apply a <u>promising community-driven practice</u> that has been successful in non-behavioral health settings
- 4. NOT be already demonstrated as effective in behavioral health setting (in literature, research, etc.)



INN Planning Cycle

4. Evaluation

- Evaluation explores the project's learning goals
- If successful, project may be funded under another MHSA component



1. Planning

- Community submits ideas for projects
- Ideas are selected to submit to the State



3. Implementation

- BHRS contracts with providers
- Providers implement projects



 State decides whether to approve ideas

Workgroup Role

- Develop an <u>inclusive</u> and <u>supportive</u> process for submitting and selecting ideas
 - Define what is needed for meaningful community participation in submitting ideas
 - Help select INN ideas to move forward
