

# “Memories of my Grandfather” Telenovela



In observance of Father’s Day, we invite you to join our webinar, “My Grandfather’s Memories”—a \*telenovela\* that portrays a multi-generational Hispanic family's emotional journey following their grandfather’s diagnosis.

Hispanics are disproportionately affected by Alzheimer’s and other dementias. They are 1.5 times more likely than non-Hispanic whites to develop the disease and face greater barriers to receiving a timely diagnosis.

During this session, we will discuss themes from the \*telenovela\*, such as early detection, diagnosis, and the early signs and symptoms of Alzheimer’s.
